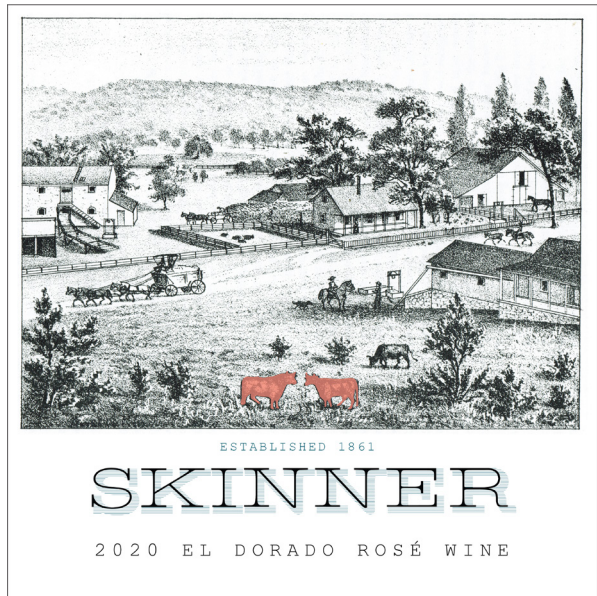
2020 EL DORADO ROSÉ WINE

THE WINE

Rosé is produced in many different styles with numerous varietals around the world. We pattern our rosé after the crisp and refreshing version from the South of France along the Cotes d'azur in areas such as Bandol, all the while continuing to honor the spirited terroir of El Dorado County.

WINEMAKER NOTES

The 2020 Rosé was made with intention. Each lot was selected specifically for rose production and farmed and harvested accordingly. The fruit from each lot was hand-sorted, macerated for 6 hours, and cold-pressed. The juice was settled and blended into a combination of concrete, stainless steel and neutral oak for an entirely native fermentation. Malolactic conversion was arrested early on in order to retain natural acidity, and bottled soon after to capture freshness.



TASTING NOTES

The 2020 rosé is wild and snappy, with brilliant aromatics of guava, lavender, lingonberry and citrus peel. The wine boasts a vivid deluge of ruby red grapefruit, punctuated with tangy floral accents.
