Rosé is produced in many different styles with numerous varietals around the world. We pattern our rosé after the crisp and refreshing version from the South of France along the Cotes d'azur in areas such as Bandol, all the while continuing to honor the spirited terroir of El Dorado County.

WINEMAKER NOTES

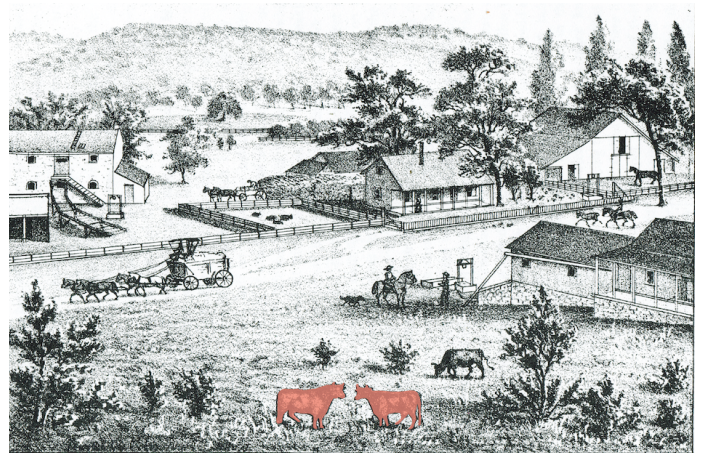
Our Rose is made with intention. Each lot was specifically selected for rose production, farmed and harvested accordingly. The fruit from each lot was hand-sorted and pressed whole cluster. The juice was settled, blended and sent to stainless steel barrels for native fermentation.

The 2022 frost vintage wiped out most of El Dorado County whites and early reds.

At Skinner, we were at half of our normal production. Coming off of a fire vintage in 2021, Skinner was short on wine and sought to put the blending skills to the test.

TASTING NOTES

With aromatics of guava, lavender, lingonberry and citrus peel, our 2022 Rosé is luxurious. The wine boasts a vivid deluge of ruby red grapefruit... crisp and fresh.
